Scoring: Double scoring (with two score cards) will be employed. Ten zone scoring will be used.

AGB Membership cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.

Closing date for entries: Sunday 8th June 2025 or when full. NB, No refunds will be given after this date.

Telephone entries not accepted. Confirmation of your entry, the Target List and Results will be published on the EMAS and Northamptonshire websites.

WA rules apply to this competition appropriate to the format of the round being shot. It is a condition of entry and admission to the venue that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the Tournament Organiser and Judge in Charge for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.

All arrows are to be accounted for.

Photography and image recording - The recommendation in the AGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy will apply. All persons wishing to record images in any format must register with the TO.

Data Protection: When entering competitions the following information may be collected and shared with TOs, scoring systems and other competitors eg, published target list and results (name, gender, bow style, DoB age category, email, phone number, club, county, region round (unless defined by age), and disability info).

Record Status

Record Status Tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result.

It is a requirement of Record Status Events that parents/guardians of juniors must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.
